Bi-lingual –Spanish/English Teaching Artists sought for highly acclaimed in-school residency program for Providence and Pawtucket Public Schools.

This is a perfect position for Performing Artists who are looking to augment a professional career with teaching. Work hours are generally weekdays 2-5 p.m. or 3-6p.m. and Saturday mornings with some additional hours as needed throughout the week. Pay is \$25-35.00 per hour and commensurate with experience. Teachers are encouraged to build their own pedagogy.

Teatro ECAS “Improving Young Lives Through the Arts in Providence” (ILAP) is an after-school theater and literacy program for Spanish native-speaking students as well as English speakers looking to improve both Spanish and English literacy while learning and practicing a performing arts course.

These classes will be taught in 8-9 week cohorts, either in the schools, or at the home of Teatro ECAS at 57 Parkis Avenue in Providence. There will be three semesters: Fall, Winter and Spring of 2021-2022. Overseen by Artistic Director Francis Parra, there will be paid training as well as monthly meetings with other teaching artists.
